

VAX TO WIN RAFFLE for 12-17 YEAR-OLD PARTICIPANTS

To highlight and support the importance of getting vaccinated, the Government of Manitoba and Manitoba Liquor and Lotteries Corporation (MBLL) in partnership with The Winnipeg Foundation will conduct a series of Raffle Draws as incentive for all Manitobans age 12-17 years old to receive 1st and 2nd doses of an approved COVID-19 Vaccine.

- For qualifying 12-17 year-old individuals there will be twenty (20) prizes consisting of two (2) separate draws for one (1) of ten (10) \$25,000.00 Scholarships for post-high school educational activity, including, but not limited to, university, college, apprenticeship training, or trade school.
- To be entered in the draw, individual Manitobans in this age-group must have received a first vaccine dose by August 2, 2021 to be eligible for the first draw, and a second vaccine dose by September 6, 2021 to be eligible for the second draw.
- Draws will take place on or about August 9, 2021 and September 13, 2021.
- Winners / winner guardians will be contacted once draws are completed and announcements of winners will be made on or about August 17, 2021 for the first draw and on or about September 21, 2021 for the second draw. The term “winner/winner guardian” shall mean the winning minor and the minor’s parent or legal guardian, as the case may be.
- Prizes to be won are listed below:
 - *NOTE: Individual participants can only win one (1) prize per draw*

Rules & Regulations

1. In order to be eligible for the draw(s):
 - a. Participants must be 12-17 years of age at the time of the cut-off for the draw events;
 - b. Participants must be residents of Manitoba or located in Manitoba and have received approved vaccinations which are registered with the Government of Manitoba; and
 - c. Participants must have their first vaccination recorded in the Manitoba Health and Seniors Care’s Public Health Information Management System (PHIMS) by 11:59 p.m. August 2, 2021 to be eligible for the first draw, and their second vaccination recorded in PHIMS by 11:59 p.m. September 6, 2021 to be eligible for the second draw. Steps for the protection of personal health information are in place to ensure privacy of data used in the draw process.
2. Anyone directly involved in the export, analysis, preparation, transmission of draw data, in executing the draw and Members of Manitoba Legislative Assembly or their immediate family members will not be eligible to win a prize.
 - a. Immediate family members are described as – Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Spouse (including common-law relationships), Child or Ward of the employee
3. All eligible Manitobans as outlined above in paragraph one, will receive one (1) entry into each of the two (2) draws for prizes.

4. Winners will be selected from eligible participants using a Random Generator supplied by 7174366 Manitoba Ltd. operating as Funding Change, a gaming supplier licensed by the Liquor, Gaming and Cannabis Authority of Manitoba.
5. Winning entries (anonymized) will be provided by the licensed gaming supplier to the Province of Manitoba to determine the corresponding name of the winner and will be witnessed and validated with an auditor present.
6. MBLL will provide to The Winnipeg Foundation the names and addresses of the winners/winner guardians.
7. Individual participants can only win one (1) prize per draw event. Eligible participants will be entered into both draw events regardless of winning a prize in the first draw.
8. Winner/winner guardian will be contacted at the time of winning the prize. They may choose to decline the prize verbally or in writing. If the winner/winner guardian declines a prize in the August draw event, the September draw will have an extra prize drawn. If a winner/winner guardian declines a prize in the September draw event, additional winners will be drawn until all prizes are awarded.
9. Efforts to contact winners will begin immediately following each draw event.
10. Representatives will make reasonable efforts and use various methods to contact the winner/winner guardian (e.g. telephone, e-mail, etc.). A minimum of at least five (5) attempts over seven (7) days will be made to contact the winner/winner guardian to obtain a consent in a form established by MBLL to claim the prize in accordance with these rules and regulations. In the event MBLL is unable to contact the winner within seven (7) days the winner will no longer be eligible for the prize. If MBLL is unable to contact the winner/winner guardian within the seven (7) days or the winner/winner guardian declines the prize for the August draw, the prize will be added to and awarded with the September draw. If MBLL is unable to contact the winner/winner guardian within the seven (7) days or the winner/winner guardian declines the prize for the September draw, MBLL will continue to draw until a winner/winner guardian is contacted and accepts the prize.
11. In order to claim a prize, the winner/winner guardian must provide their consent and identification as outlined below within seven (7) days of being notified that they are a potential winner/winner guardian and by doing so the winner/winner guardian unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these rules and regulations.
12. To complete a prize claim, winners/winner guardians will be required to provide valid photo identification to confirm identity. Providing valid identification to confirm identity will be done in a manner agreed upon by all parties (in-person or virtually). Types of acceptable pieces of valid photo identification include:
 - a. Valid Manitoba Driver's License
 - b. Manitoba Identification Card (MPI enhanced Photo ID)
 - c. Canadian Forces ID
 - d. Canadian Firearms Possession & Acquisition License
 - e. Indigenous / Treaty Card
 - f. Passport or Travel Visa

- g. Canadian Citizenship Card
 - h. Acceptable non-photo identification must be presented together:
 - i. Birth Certificate
 - ii. Provincial Health Registration Card
13. Winners/winner guardians will be required to sign a release acknowledging acceptance of prizes as awarded.
14. Winners will be required to have their name and likeness used for the purpose of communicating winner information and confirm prizes have been claimed for each draw.
15. The Prize is a scholarship the details of which include:
- a. The scholarship will be administered by The Winnipeg Foundation and the winner guardians are required to enter into a Scholarship Agreement with The Winnipeg Foundation in the form established by the Winnipeg Foundation;
 - b. The scholarship is \$25,000 (CDN) and paid at the time the winner meets the eligibility criteria for the scholarship in accordance with the Scholarship Agreement between the winner guardian and The Winnipeg Foundation;
 - c. The scholarship will be held in-trust with The Winnipeg Foundation until the winner meets the eligibility criteria for the scholarship; and
 - d. The scholarship can be used for post-high school educational activity, including, but not limited to, university, college, apprenticeship training, or trade school located anywhere in the world.
16. The following criteria must be met for a winner to receive the prize, which will be paid to the winner by The Winnipeg Foundation as a one-time, lump sum payment:
- a. compliance with these rules and regulations;
 - b. proof of Canadian residency;
 - c. Canadian social insurance number;
 - d. proof of registration in post-secondary education or training at a university, college or trade-school commencing within twelve (12) months of registration;
 - e. provision of a copy of a birth certificate or other government-issued documentation evidencing proof of age of eighteen (18) years of age or older; and
 - f. winners will have until the date of their 20th birthday to claim their award.
17. The winners shall be responsible for all tax treatment and liabilities in respect to the scholarship. The Winnipeg Foundation will issue a T4 tax form to the winner. If the tuition owing is less than \$25,000, the winner may use the remaining funds for other educational expenses.
18. The prize will be paid to the winner only. The parents or guardians of a winner cannot claim the award on behalf of the winner.
19. If any winner becomes deceased prior to receiving their award, or if a winner does not satisfy the eligibility criteria for receiving their prize as established by these rules and regulations or the terms of any agreement entered into with The Winnipeg Foundation, the winner shall not receive the prize and the \$25,000 award shall remain in *The MBLL Vaccine Lottery Fund* administered by The Winnipeg Foundation.

20. If there are funds remaining in *The MBLL Vaccine Lottery Fund* after all of the prizes have been paid to all winners and there are no longer any winners who can become eligible to receive a prize, The Winnipeg Foundation shall establish a scholarship endowment fund for purposes determined by The Winnipeg Foundation in consultation with MBLL pursuant to a scholarship endowment fund agreement between The Winnipeg Foundation and MBLL that will be subject to The Winnipeg Foundation's Spending Policy and Fees Policies, and all of the funds remaining in *The MBLL Vaccine Lottery Fund* shall be paid or transferred to such scholarship endowment fund.

Privacy

21. All personal information and personal health information used in the various processes of the Vax to Win Raffle is confidentially maintained in accordance with *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, C.C.S.M. c. F175 (FIPPA) and *The Personal Health Information Act*, C.C.S.M. c. P 33.5 (PHIA) and may only be disclosed in accordance therewith or as may otherwise be required by law. Any questions regarding the collection, use or disclosure of the personal information or personal health information used in the Vax to Win Raffle may be directed as follows:

- a. Manitoba Health and Seniors Care (MHSC) or Manitoba Finance's Government Inquiries Line are authorized to collect the personal information and personal health information about you under s. 13(1) of PHIA and s. 36(1)(b) of FIPPA.
- b. Your personal health information and personal information is protected in accordance with PHIA and FIPPA and cannot be used or disclosed for other purposes, unless you consent or as authorized by PHIA or FIPPA.
- c. If you have any questions or concerns about MHSC's collection of your personal information or personal health information, please contact MHSC at PIMA@gov.mb.ca.

Opt-Out

22. Individuals may choose not to participate in the Vax to Win Raffle. In order to withdraw from participating in the Vax to Win Raffle, you will need to provide your information to MHSC by filling out the online form located at the following link: <https://forms.gov.mb.ca/vaccine-lottery-withdrawal/>, or by calling the Manitoba government inquiries line at 204-945-3744. Only necessary personal information and personal health information will be collected to withdraw you from participating in the Vax to Win Raffle.

- a. Deadline to opt-out of the first draw is 11:59 pm August 2, 2021 and deadline to opt-out of the second draw is 11:59 pm September 6, 2021.
- b. Individuals choosing to opt-out prior to the first draw will also be automatically opted-out of the second draw.
- c. Individuals who opt-out of the first draw but want to opt-in for the second draw must complete the opt-in process to be included back in the second draw.

Opt-In

23. In order to be included in the Vax to Win Raffle, your immunization record must be recorded in the PHIMS. Manitoba residents who received their COVID-19 vaccination at a Manitoba [immunization clinic](#), pharmacy, or medical clinic will already have their immunization records recorded in PHIMS.

24. Manitoba residents who received their COVID-19 vaccine outside of the province or at a site not included in the above list will need to have their vaccination information added into PHIMS. In order to do this, you will need proof of immunization from the jurisdiction where you received your

vaccine and you will need to follow the directions on the following website:
<https://manitoba.ca/covid19/vaccine/snowbirds.html>.

25. Manitoba residents with a Manitoba health card who have received the COVID-19 vaccine can verify that their immunization record is included in PHIMS by requesting a copy online at <https://gov.mb.ca/covid19/vaccine/immunization-record.html#immunization-records>. Some individuals who have received approved vaccinations may not have their vaccination status recorded in PHIMS. If the Government of Manitoba is unable to confirm vaccination status information about an individual, they will not be eligible for the draws. Having a Manitoba health card is not required to be eligible for the Vax to Win Raffle. If you do not have a health card and would like to verify your immunization record is recorded in the PHIMS, you may contact your [local public health office](#) and they can provide you with a copy.

Disclaimer

The Government of Manitoba and MBLL shall undertake reasonable efforts to ensure all individuals who may qualify for the Vax to Win Raffle are included as part of the data set provided to the licensed gaming supplier. Notwithstanding, the Government of Manitoba and MBLL make no representations or warranties in respect to the Vax to Win Raffle and specifically disclaim any and all warranties, express or implied, in regard thereto including, without limiting the foregoing, any cost, injury, loss or damage to an individual in the event the individual is not included as part of the data set provided to the licensed gaming supplier in one or more of the raffle draws as a result of anything done or omitted to be done on the part of the Government of Manitoba or MBLL. It is the responsibility of all individuals who wish to participate in the Vax to Win Raffle to confirm their vaccination status has been recorded in the PHIMS.

Participants acknowledge and agree that the Government of Manitoba, MBLL and their agents and contractors shall not be responsible or liable for, and are hereby released from, any and all costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind or nature whatsoever, due in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, to participation in the Vax to Win Raffle, or from a participant's acceptance, receipt, possession and/or use or misuse of any prize, including, without limitation, to such prize's quality or fitness for a particular purpose.
